City Manager Dan Hudson gave a brief overview regarding the enhancements to the Wastewater Treatment Plant.

The City Commission discussed the matter and had several questions. They asked if the plant is a health risk?

Dave Peters stated that the odor is an offensive smell sometimes but, is not a health issue, unless you are in a confined space for a long period of time. He reviewed odor control components to cover or conceal the large tanks as well as odor control components.

The Commission viewed before and after photos of the Plant and discussed plant capacity.

Dave Peters stated the plant can sustain capacity to the year 2036 based on today's development.
