Station 2 serves the south city zone with 1 Engine and 1 Rescue. Additionally, discussions are underway to expand into the north city zone with Station 3. The Battalion Chief serves as the chief officer on duty at all times to manage the shift and command emergency operations.



Our greatest asset is our employees, all of whom are highly trained, efficient, and dedicated to the profession. Our employees work a 24/48 schedule with a 3-week Kelly Day. Stuart Fire Rescue takes great pride in ensuring protocols and equipment are up to date, including an all ALS fleet, providing the ability to transport patients to comprehensive stroke and trauma centers.

- Emergency Vehicle Operators Course (EVOC) Certificate
- Valid Florida Class E Driver License
- Current CPR card (Healthcare provider or equivalent)
- Current ACLS (if applicable)
- High School Diploma or Equivalent
- All college diplomas/degrees (if applicable)
- Military DD214 (if applicable), or other acceptable documents
