Public Works announces its biennial photo contest for student, amateur, and professional photographers

Stuart, FL – Today the City of Stuart Public Works Department announced it will be sponsoring a contest for a 2019 "Creating A Healthier River...Day-by-Day" Calendar. The department is inviting student, amateur, and professional photographers to submit their entries for a chance to be selected for the 2019 calendar edition.

Each photographer may submit up to six (6) entries and all images must have been taken within the approximate City of Stuart city limits, which extends from Jensen Beach Boulevard on the north side, south to Slater Street, and from the south fork of the St. Lucie River on the west to the Intracoastal Waterway on the east. All images must be in landscape (horizontal) orientation and may be cropped by the City to fit the final dimensions of the calendar page. No recognizable people or business signage should appear in the photos and each image must be accompanied by a photo quality print in addition.

At least thirteen (13) images will be eligible for use in the calendar and winners will be contacted once judging is complete. In addition to work being published in the 2019 Calendar, the winning photos will appear on the City's website for the entire year with photo credits given.
